We offer a first-hand expense-paid opportunity to see what it's like to work in manufacturing and the trades.



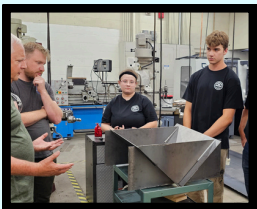
What We Do

- Exposure - You'll be exposed to carpentry, welding, machining, design, business, and operations.



What You Learn

- This is a real work situation - we put you in the middle of quotas, deadlines, and projects.
- We teach principles of manufacturing as you do them. That's the best way to retain learning.
- You'll manufacture with wood and metal - it's easy to learn how to make things, but manufacturing is similar regardless of what you make.
- Our guides will help you learn basics of design, fabrication, quality, customer service, and sales, .
- Students are exposed to several pathways and success skills in communication, leadership, problem-solving, and teamwork.



What You Earn

Program graduates both earn and learn. We offer the following:
